

Studio 68 Dress Code for 2010-11

At Studio 68, we follow a dress code for weekly classes. We believe this encourages unity, discipline, and focus among our students. Street clothes are not allowed in class. It is important that dancers present a neat and elegant appearance to minimize distractions in the classroom. Hair must be pulled away from the face, up off the neckline, and secured to the head. Ballet buns are preferred.

Acro	Any color footless tights (can be stirrup or adaptatoe)	Any color/style leotard	Note: Shorts and t-shirts are not allowed. Ponytails are acceptable for this class.
Pointe	Pink footed tights	Black leotard, any style	Based on individual fit. European pink is preferred. Pointe shoes must be measured at a dance retail store and approved by your instructor before sewing. Ribbon should be 7/8" with either wide or thin elastic. See instructor for sewing instructions.
Adults	Comfortable, non-restrictive clothing		<u>Tap:</u> Black Bloch Tap Flex tap shoes (#SO388 or #SO389)

The only exception to this dress code is the last class of the month - Color Week. During this week, students may wear any color and style dancewear to all classes. Shoe and hair requirements remain the same. Also, please note that company members may have different requirements, so be sure to check with your instructor before purchasing anything.

All dancewear and shoes can be purchased at **The Dancer Store** in Melody Square. This will ensure that you get high-quality items that follow the dress code at Studio 68 and fit correctly - saving you time and money! Normal store hours are 11am-5pm Tuesday-Friday and 10am-2pm Saturday.
