TUITIONS & FEES 2010-2011

Our tuition is based on a sliding scale and calculated per family—the more classes your family takes, the more you save! You may choose to pay monthly or by the year. Monthly tuition is due by the 1st of each month.

A 10% discount is available when paying the year in full. A lesser discount is available for those who must pay by credit card. Payment must be received by August 1 in order to receive the discount.

We accept cash, check, MasterCard and Visa. There is a five day grace period on most payments. When paying after the 5th of the month, please add \$10 to your payment. Tuition is not pro-rated, not refundable, and not transferable. All classes missed for holidays, studio closings, or illness may be made up according to a posted schedule.

A **registration fee** of \$25 per dancer is due upon registration.

Ballet Company members are charged a yearly fee for their weekly technique class. This fee is due on the first class of the season. This fee is \$100 for Level 1 and Level 2 students and \$125 for Level 3 and Elite Level students.

A **costume deposit** of \$35 per costume is due by October 1. A late fee of \$10 per costume will be added for costume deposits not paid by October 5. Costumes are non-returnable; therefore, costume payments are non-refundable and non-transferable. Once costume orders have been placed, you are responsible for the balance, regardless of whether your dancer completes the dance season. A **costume balance** of \$35 (for children's sizes in traditional classes) or \$45 (for adult sizes in traditional classes) is due February 1. *Please note: Company dancers' costume prices are not included in this price table.* A late fee of \$10 per costume, per month will be charged for costumes not paid in full by February 5.

A **recital fee** of \$45 per account is due November 1. A late fee of \$10 will be added for recital fees not paid by November 5. This fee allows us to stage a professional production at the John A. Walker Community Center on the third Sunday in May. It includes five (5) tickets per account and one (1) souvenir program book.

Private lessons are available at a rate of \$20 per half-hour or \$30 per hour for single dancers. Semi-private lessons are available at a rate of \$20 per person per hour or \$15 per person per half-hour. These lessons offer individual, concentrated attention and are invaluable in improving technique or mastering complex movements. Students participating in competitions, pageants, and talent shows often choose to take private or semi-private lessons to better prepare.

Studio 68 is happy to host **birthday parties**. We provide 45 minutes of dance instruction and entertainment, party music, and the perfect location with lots of space. You may invite up to 15 children and cost is \$100. See the office manager for details.
